## **Book Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What was your takeaway theme for The International Bank of Bob?
- 2. Does this book effect your desire to travel to developing countries?
- 3. Which story or lender resonated most deeply with you? Why?
- 4. Bob talks about his preconceived ideas based on images by American news programs, movies and television -- were there particular stories that challenged your own ideas about the countries he visited?
- 5. What did you think about the structure of the book and the use of footnotes?
- 6. Bob wanted to avoid telling this story as a typical American tourist who focuses on his own personal journey. Is he successful in this? What examples from the book support that?
- 7. What are the benefits and drawbacks of fighting poverty with microfinance versus traditional aid?
- 8. Have you lent on Kiva before? If so, will Bob's stories influence who you lend to in the future? If you haven't made a Kiva loan, what do you think you'd look for in a borrower or microfinance institution?
- 9. Bob speaks about a number of organizations that he donated to, but that Kiva was the one that finally stuck for him. If you're a Kiva lender, what made Kiva "stick"
